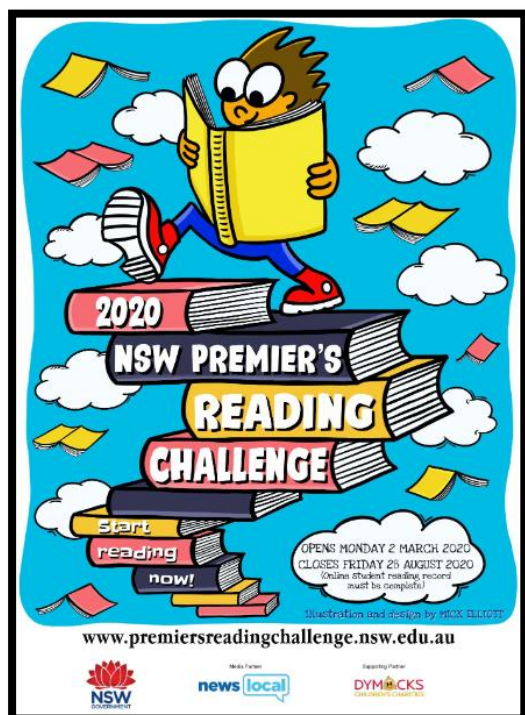

Library Monitors will receive their badges and be inducted at our school assembly held on Monday 23, March 2020 together with our SRC Representatives for 2020.



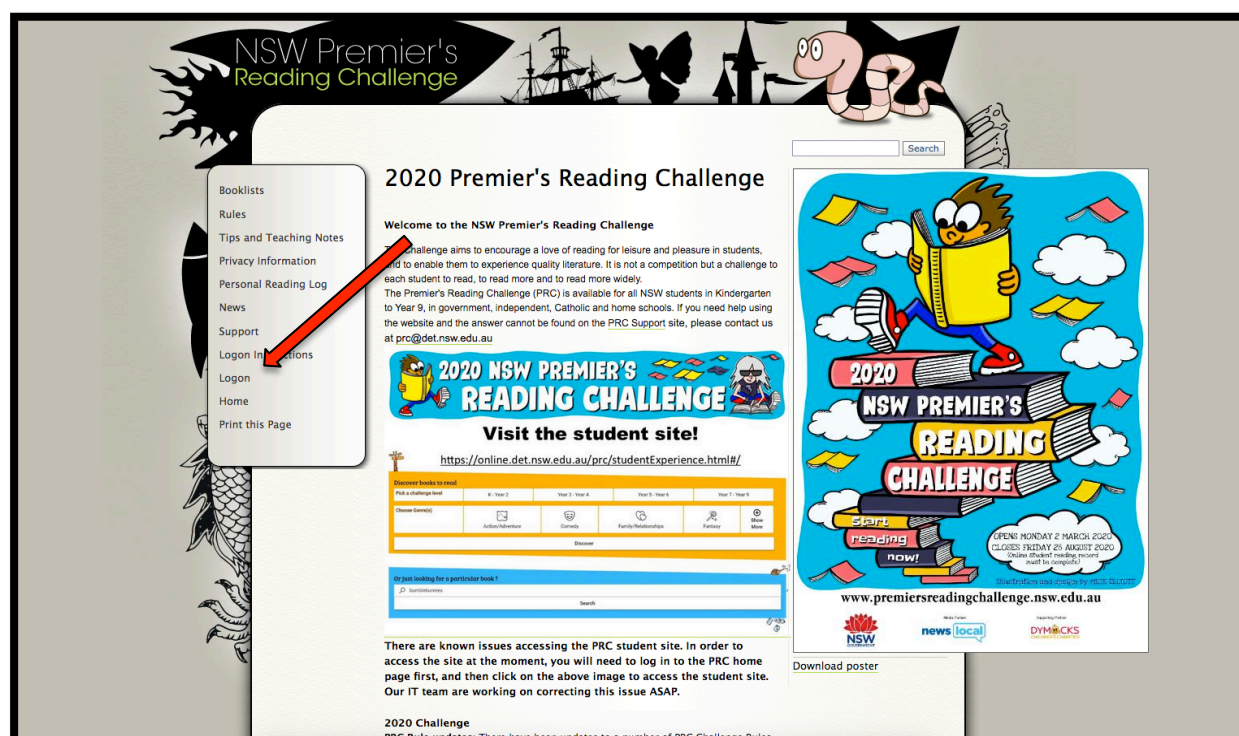
Premiers Reading Challenge 2020 – Online Reading Logs now open!
